
EDGE SMS AND MOBILE APP

We are always working on our products and year to date, we have made some significant improvements across our software suite. If you would like any further information or training on any of the changes mentioned below, please let your solutions specialist know.

Absence Notification from Caregivers

This is our latest time saving addition to both edge and edge mobile app. Caregivers can now securely send in an absence notification for their child, to the school, via the edge mobile app.

This is configured at the bottom of the Admin>Setup>School Settings page.



Schools can edit the text that caregivers would see on the app and can include the school phone number so the school can be phoned directly. If your school has the option to receive messages by text the 'Allow text message' box can also be ticked.


When caregivers send an absence notification it is saved directly into Edge Attendance along with a suitable note that lets the school know that it was received from the caregiver app.

Family Roll

A new family roll list has also been added on the People>Student Lists page. This prints out the contact details for all students, grouped by family based on the caregiver who has "student address" ticked.

Live Reporting:

We have released 'live reporting' which gives schools the option of pushing assessment graphs to the caregiver



mobile app and portal. These are the graphs found on the People>Student Details>Assessment Summary page. Schools will have the option of when and which graphs to publish, and to include a comment.

As a precursor to this functionality an Achievement button has been added to the mobile app which shows all achievement data that has been added to the student.

Changes to Purple Banner:

We have modified the top banner within edge as follows:

- Increased the font size of the student's name.
- Included legal name.
- Added photo permission and internet permission.
- Moved the "Next" button to the right side of the name select box.
- Filter selections (Current Students, Pre-Enrols, Leavers) are now sticky when selecting students from the drop-down list.
- Added "Time at School" (YMD and weeks).
- Multiple Ethnicities are listed with a +# when more than three.
- Multiple lwi are listed with a +# when more than two.

Assay3 (edge analytics)

We have a new developer that has been working exclusively on Assay3 and he has made a number of significant changes which we are sure you will find enhance the product. Assay3 is now also available for all our edge primary schools also. Assay users can see the status of their students, classes, year groups and entire school at a glance and board reports can now be produced with a few clicks. If you would like to start using Assay, please get in contact with your solution specialist or the support desk so we can help you maximise the functionality in this software. We are confident it will simplify your data analysis so that you can spend time improving outcomes for your students, rather than manipulating raw data.




CONFERENCE 2022

WELCOME TO OUR NEW SCHOOLS FOR TERM 3

You may be aware that Schola Limited which sells the Assembly SMS package is to close its business at the end of this year. As a result NZ schools that are currently using Assembly as their SMS provider are transitioning to a new SMS system.

We have been working with both Assembly and the Ministry of Education to ease the process of changing SMS providers. We have demonstrated our software to a large number of schools and are now migrating and training the schools which have made the decision to move to edge. Our migration process has been refined and we are now able to upload a significant amount of data from Assembly into edge within one day. This has enabled many former Assembly schools to now use edge as their SMS from day 1 of term 3. We look forward to more schools moving to edge during the remainder of the year and trust our improved data migration process makes the transition to edge easier.

We would like to thank the edge schools that have provided references and spoken to Assembly schools when asked. We appreciate both the support of our existing schools and would like to welcome our new users to edge. As always your feedback is valued so please let us know if we can be of further assistance.

Te Rito

We were informed by the Ministry of Education that the deployment of Te Rito is currently on pause as they work through international standards for data security which will enable schools to safely connect to Te Rito.

We are continuing to work with the Ministry of Education on this project and support the pause while data security standards are considered. Data security is of upmost importance, so we are fully supportive of the Ministry's decision.

Reporting

Although mid-year reporting has only recently been completed, we would like to remind schools wishing to change their end of year reports to let us know as soon as possible what changes are needed. Historically we have had many requests for changes made close to the end of year reporting deadline which we know is a stressful time for teachers. If you are aware of what changes you need to make to your end of year reports, please let us know now so we are able to complete the changes before deadlines loom.

Edge Pay

We continue to see more schools opt to use our Edge Pay service. The service enables caregivers to make payments to their school via the edge parent portal. This can be done by using either the edge mobile app or the web version.

There is no cost to the school for this service as a small transaction surcharge is incurred on the caregiver's credit or debit card to cover the credit card merchant fee.

Feedback from the current Edge Pay users is very supportive including that schools have seen a marked increase in payment of invoices in a timely fashion and that edge pay reduces the workload of the administration staff at the school.
